ENTRY CONDITIONS

All exhibitors must pay gate fee.

Everyone on showgrounds must have a wristband.

1. All prize winners must take part in the Grand Parade
2. Each horse can have a maximum of 3 starts in the showjumping ring.
3. Ponies may be ridden by adults
4. Children competing in Rider Classes must compete in their own age group.
5. If a judge considers an exhibit of not sufficient merit, no award will be made
6. Ponies must not exceed 14hh, galloways must be over 14hh and not exceed 15 hh, hacks are to be over 15hh.
7. Stewards reserve the right to make additional classes if advised
8. Only maiden/novice competitors of the age of 17 years and under can compete in the Restricted Ring
9. Horse/handler/rider from the restricted ring may compete in the horses led/ridden breed classes in the open ring.
10. Horses are not to be ridden in the vicinity of pavilion, liquor bar, side show area or cattle judging area.
11. Horses may compete in Show Horse and Show Hunter.
12. All riders in the show horse and showjumping events must wear a helmet.
13. All competitors must fill out and sign a Horse Health Declaration form. An electronic copy of the Horse Health Declaration can be downloaded from <http://www.qcas.net.au/bio-security> or <http://prostononline.info/showschedule.html>
14. **Supreme Hack of Show will be judged at the conclusion of the Grand Parade and will be eligible for the Cliff Perkins Memorial Trophy for Supreme Exhibit of Show.**

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- All prize winners must take part in the Grand Parade
- Riders under 17 years can compete in either the Junior Competitors Challenge OR Junior & Senior Horse Challenge, but they may not compete in both events
- If a horse's rider is changed, they are not eligible for the overall Challenge award
- Numbers will be restricted if necessary, and at the discretion of the Chief Steward
- Horses are not to be ridden in the vicinity of pavilion, liquor bar, side show area or cattle judging area
- Junior riders must wear a helmet.
- Horses do not have to be a registered Australian Stock Horse to compete.






