Show Rules & Regulations

1. Proston Show is conducted subject to the regulations of Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Shows (QCAS), Biosecurity Queensland, the Constitution and Rules of this Association and any Regulations which apply to individual sections.
2. The Association will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any accident, loss, damage or mis-delivery of livestock or any other exhibit which may occur at any time covered by Show activity, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any cost or action, legal or otherwise arising through any accident, loss, damage, or mis-delivery. All care will be taken but no responsibility accepted.
3. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors and Space Hirers to comply with the current Workplace Health and Safety Act together with all State and Local Government Regulations and space hirers must have their own Public Liability Insurance and produce identification when requested.
4. All persons entering the Showgrounds during any period covered by Association activities shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Proston Show Association and will pay admission on Show Day unless issued with an approved Show Association pass.
5. The President, or Steward in Charge of any section of the Show has the discretionary right to refuse an entry by an Exhibitor any time, without expressing reason.
6. The Association reserves the right to refuse entry to any Stall Holder if the Association reasonably believes it is necessary to do so to ensure that the standard, quality, and safety of the Show is maintained.
7. To comply with the Association's insurance requirements, ALL incidents must be reported to the President or Secretary who will complete an incident Form.
8. During any period covered by Show activities, all Livestock must be the responsibility of the Owner or Owners representative.
9. Livestock Stewards have the right to arrange for the removal from the grounds, at the owner's expense, of any beast found to be diseased, dangerously uncontrollable, or otherwise unfit for the purposes of Exhibition. Any objections or protests should be submitted to the Secretary in writing for consideration at the next General Committee meeting of the Association.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

All exhibitors must pay gate fee. Everyone on showgrounds must have a wristband.

1. No traffic movement until the conclusion of the Grand Parade
2. All Queensland Road Rules apply to entrants whilst in the showgrounds. Excessive noise (outside of competition), speed, burnouts, donuts, or other unruly driving will not be tolerated, and offenders will be disqualified and directed to leave
3. Alcohol is prohibited outside of the designated bar area, any offenders will be disqualified and directed to leave. Patrons must be mindful of Driving Under the Influence laws if responsible for any competition vehicles.
4. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Chief Steward will be final
