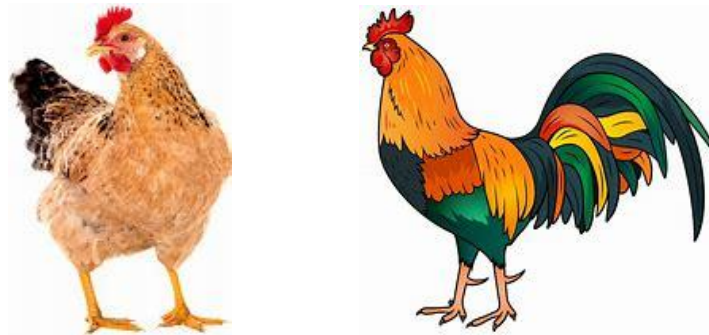

Presentation of Awards will take place at the Poultry Pavilion at 3pm after the Grand Parade. Birds may be removed from the Pavilion after 3-30 pm. on Show day only after the Presentation of Awards and with Stewards' supervision.

Prize Money: can be collected from the Secretary's Office before 6pm on Show Day

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- **ALL BIRDS MUST BE A BREED, VARIETY AND COLOUR AS RECOGNIZED IN THE AUSTRALIAN POULTRY STANDARDS**
- **Stewards may add classes according to the number of Entries received.**
 - **Breed / Variety / Colour are to be specified on the entry form.**
 - **No replacement entries accepted.**
- All birds including Junior Exhibits are to be the bona fida property of the Exhibitor.
- Judges will determine the merits of exhibits according to the approved Poultry Standards.
- Exhibitors may be present at the time of judging, under the direction of the Chief Steward.
- No correspondence or dispute will be entered into after the completion of judging.
- All birds will be clean and disease-free.
- All persons are to abide by the Rules and Regulations of this Society
- **ALL PERSONS** are to pay Gate Entry Fee unless holding a Proston Show Society Pass.
- The Society retains the discretionary right to accept or refuse entries.
- **JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:**
- **Open to children 15 YEARS AND UNDER.**

All Junior Exhibitors should have their participation endorsed by a Parent or Guardian.
Birds should be selected and prepared by the Junior Exhibitor, adult supervision allowed.
Junior Exhibitors to pen their own birds, adult supervision allowed.
Junior Exhibitors who enter in Open Classes are to pay Entry Fees for those Classes.



DEMONSTRATION SCHOOL

- The Poultry Pavilion wishes to help all Junior and Novice exhibitors to learn more about the art of Poultry showing.
- The Judge for the day, and other experienced Show persons, will be invited to give demonstrations on the following points:
 - Selecting suitable birds for showing, proper handling procedures, the preparation of Show birds and what the Judge looks for will be covered
- Please see the Stewards to be given a suitable time to attend.

YOUNG JUDGES, POULTRY.

- **Adjudicator:** Appointed Poultry Pavilion Judge. (To be announced).
 - **Chief Steward:** Les Robinson. Ph **0429 839 762**
- Young Judges Competition will be held after the completion of the main Pavilion Judging.
- **The Nomination Form is included on the General Entry Form page, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by Friday 27th February..**
 - Nomination is Free.
 - a) One Class of 4 Birds are to be assessed by the Student.
 - b) The Student will place the birds in order of merit, and speak on the reason for their choices.
 - c) The Judge will rate Students on how well they speak and on how their placings match with those of the Judge.
 - **Class 1.** Under 15 Years Awards: 1st; 2nd; 3rd.
 - **Class 2.** 15 Years to 25 Years. Awards: 1st; 2nd; 3rd.
 - **Class 2 Winner** is eligible to contest the State Final in Toowoomba 2025.
 - Entry form for the State Final will be made available on Show Day.

The area adjacent to the Poultry Pavilion is a Restricted Parking Zone between the hours of 9.00am to 3pm. Please remove your vehicles to outside the grounds by 9.00am.
