Show Rules & Regulations

- Proston Show is conducted subject to the regulations of Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Shows (QCAS), Biosecurity Queensland, the Constitution and Rules of this Association and any Regulations which apply to individual sections.
- 2. The Association will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any accident, loss, damage or mis-delivery of livestock or any other exhibit which may occur at any time covered by Show activity, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Association blameless and indemnify it against any cost or action, legal or otherwise arising through any accident, loss, damage, or mis-delivery. All care will be taken but no responsibility accepted.
- It is the responsibility of Exhibitors and Space Hirers to comply with the current Workplace Health and Safety Act together with all State and Local Government Regulations and space hirers must have their own Public Liability Insurance and produce identification when requested.
- 4. All persons entering the Showgrounds during any period covered by Association activities shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Proston Show Association and will pay admission on Show Day unless issued with an approved Show Association pass.
- 5. The President, or Steward in Charge of any section of the Show has the discretionary right to refuse an entry by an Exhibitor any time, without expressing reason.
- 6. The Association reserves the right to refuse entry to any Stall Holder if the Association reasonably believes it is necessary to do so to ensure that the standard, quality, and safety of the Show is maintained.
- 7. To comply with the Association's insurance requirements, ALL incidents must be reported to the President or Secretary who will complete an incident Form.
- 8. During any period covered by Show activities, all Livestock must be the responsibility of the Owner or Owners representative.
- 9. Livestock Stewards have the right to arrange for the removal from the grounds, at the owner's expense, of any beast found to be diseased, dangerously uncontrollable, or otherwise unfit for the purposes of Exhibition. Any objections or protests should be submitted to the Secretary in writing for consideration at the next General Committee meeting of the Association.

Exhibits may be penned on Friday by arrangement with the stewards. **Entry Fee \$1 per bird. Prize Money: First \$4 Second \$2**. Junior exhibitors have been exempted from entry fees.

All exhibitors must pay gate fee. Everyone on showgrounds must have a wristband.

- 1. All persons shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of this Association including animal bio-security precautions as published in the General Schedule
- 2. The Association retains the discretionary right to accept or refuse entries.
- 3. All birds must be the bona fida property of the Exhibitor.
- 4. Stewards have the discretionary right to add or alter classes as deemed necessary. Please write variety and/or colour on the entry form. No replacement entries accepted.
- 5. Judges to determine the merits of exhibits according to the approved Poultry Standards.
- Exhibitors may be present at the time of judging, under the direction of the Chief Steward.
- 7. No correspondence or dispute will be entered into after the completion of judging.
- 8. After the awarding of Grand Champion Fowl of Show, the reserve bird from the same section is eligible for Reserve Grand Champion of Show.
- 9. All birds will be clean and disease-free.
- Junior Exhibitors open to children under 15 years of age. Birds should be selected and prepared by the Junior Exhibitor, adult supervision permitted.
- 11. Junior Exhibitors must pen their own birds.
- 12. Young Judges Finals for Poultry will take place at the Toowoomba Royal Show in 2024. To be eligible, Finalists must have been winners at a local Show. Details available from the Secretary.
- 13. Birds may be removed from the Pavilion after 3:30pm on Show Day only after the Presentation of Awards and with Stewards' supervision.

Competitors must have removed their vehicles from the showgrounds by 9:00am.

SALE BIRDS - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Birds may be offered for sale in the Poultry Pavilion and may be entered for judging or sale only. The Association retains the discretionary right to accept or refuse entries.
- 2. A card with the price and phone number of the vendor should be posted on the relevant cage after the completion of judging.
- 3. Sale agreements will be between the vendor and purchaser only.
- 4. Stewards will not be responsible for Sale arrangements.
- 5. If not entered for Judging, a pen fee of \$1.00 per bird will apply to all sale birds with a maximum of single, pair or trio to a pen
- 6. Birds must be Purebred and in sound condition.
- 7. All birds must be removed from the Pavilion at penning out time.
- 8. Enter details of Sale Birds in the form provided on the back of the General Entry Form.
